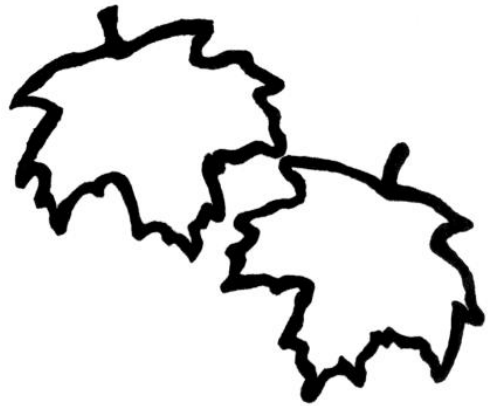

Where & When: Our hour-long programs are held on Mondays and Fridays at 2:00 pm at the Faith United Methodist Church, 899 Dorset St. in South Burlington. The meeting room is handicapped accessible.

Cost: Memberships cost \$40 for the Fall 2010 semester or \$75 for the entire 2010-2011 academic year and entitle people over age 50 to attend all lectures. You may send in the membership form or join at any session.

Non-members of any age may attend any lecture for a \$5 donation. These donations can be credited towards membership if the person later decides to become a member.
